

FEES 2024/5

Module 1 and 2 training is the same across all the programmes, however, from Module 2 students can opt for Clinical Skills training in addition to the core training. In order to take on practice clients prior to the clinical programmes students must complete the Pre-clinical Skills course or the Module 2C Coaching Skills course.

Fees are the same for both Distance Learning and In-Person training.

PLEASE NOTE

Fees may be subject to changes each year determined by programme adjustments and inflation.

Clinical requirements may extend beyond the core taught academic programmes. For all Clinical Diplomas, individual supervisions will be required in addition to group supervisions in order to reach and complete clinical requirements. Transition year students do not have a studies advisor.

ADDITIONAL COSTS

Payment Plan fee for those paying their fees in instalments (deductible if payment in full by 1st October)	£100
Late payment fee for late payments of training fees if not agreed as part of the payment plan (we encourage students to keep in touch if they find themselves in financial difficulty)	£100
Late completion fee (for students completing and exiting after graduation but before 1st October)	£250
Individual therapy (payable to the therapist) – weekly therapy of 40 hours per year	£40-70 p/h
Individual supervision (therapy) (if required over and above those included in the fees)	£65 p/h
Individual supervision (coaching) (if required over and above those included in the fees)	£75 p/h
Seminar (for students taking a missed or extra seminar)	£200
Right Relations (optional extra for students after Block 1)	£400
